ROAD TRAFFIC (EXEMPTION FROM SECTION 35) ORDER 2005

ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

Paragraph

- 1. Citation and commencement
- 2. Exemption

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Exemption from Section 35) Order 2005 and shall come into operation on 10th November 2005.

Exemption

- 2.—(1) Section 35(1) of the Act shall not apply to any person who is a full-time national serviceman or operationally ready national serviceman enlisted in the Special Constabulary of the Special Operations Command of the Singapore Police Force, and who is in possession of a certificate or document issued to him by the competent authority of the Singapore Police Force to drive a Class 4 motor vehicle, in relation to the driving by him of such a motor vehicle in the possession of the Singapore Police Force.
- (2) Section 35(2) of the Act shall not apply to the Singapore Police Force.
