In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act 1961, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

**Citation and period in force**

1.—(1) This Order is the Road Traffic (Cycle of Peace 2024 — Exemption) Order 2024.

(2) This Order is in force on 29 September 2024 starting 7 a.m. and ending 1 p.m.

**Definitions**

2. In this Order —

“specified event” means the Cycle of Peace 2024 event organised by Ambulance Wish Singapore (UEN 200516006W) on 29 September 2024;

“specified road” means the road delineated by the black-coloured line in the map set out in the Schedule.

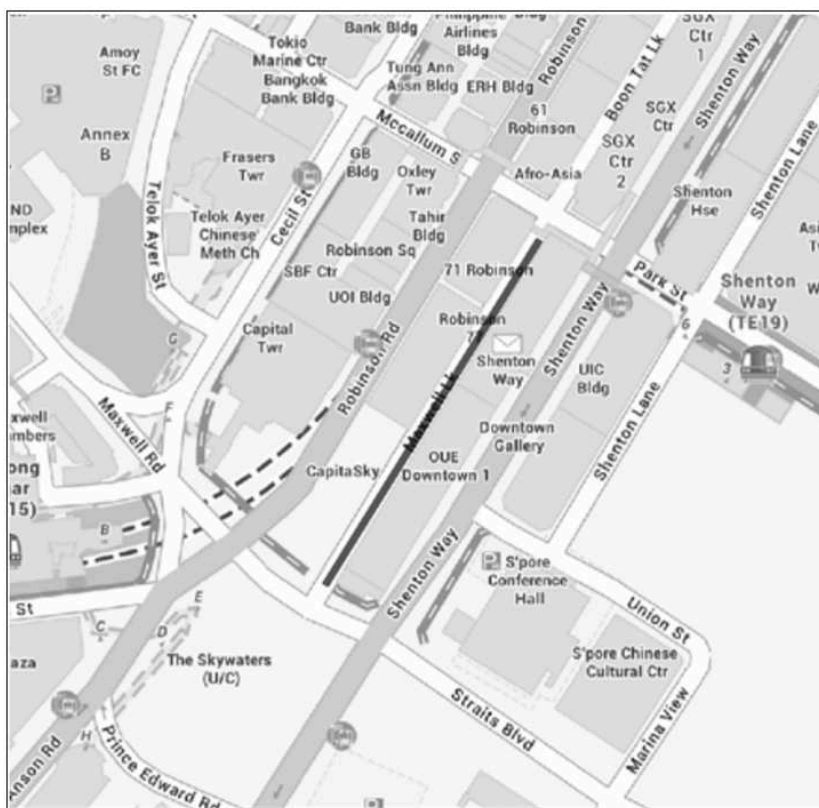
## Exemption for riding bicycle

3. Rules 5, 6, 7, 7A, 8, 10 and 11 of the Road Traffic (Bicycles, Three-wheeled Pedal Cycles, Trishaws and Recumbent Devices — Road Conduct) Rules (R 3) do not apply to an individual who rides a bicycle on the specified road during and in connection with the specified event.
