## Citation and period in force

- **1.**—(1) This Order is the Road Traffic (Cycle of Peace 2024 Exemption) Order 2024.
- (2) This Order is in force on 29 September 2024 starting 7 a.m. and ending 1 p.m.

### **Definitions**

- 2. In this Order
  - "specified event" means the Cycle of Peace 2024 event organised by Ambulance Wish Singapore (UEN 200516006W) on 29 September 2024;
  - "specified road" means the road delineated by the black-coloured line in the map set out in the Schedule.


# **Exemption for riding bicycle**

**3.** Rules 5, 6, 7, 7A, 8, 10 and 11 of the Road Traffic (Bicycles, Three-wheeled Pedal Cycles, Trishaws and Recumbent Devices — Road Conduct) Rules (R 3) do not apply to an individual who rides a bicycle on the specified road during and in connection with the specified event.
