# ROAD TRAFFIC (POWER-ASSISTED BICYCLES) (EXEMPTION FROM PART I AND SECTION 91) ORDER 2004

#### ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

#### Paragraph

- 2. Definition
- 3. Exemption

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport hereby makes the following Order:

## Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Power-Assisted Bicycles) (Exemption from Part I and Section 91) Order 2004 and shall come into operation on 1st January 2005.

### **Definition**

2. In this Order, "power-assisted bicycle" means a bicycle that is equipped with an electric motor and that may be propelled by muscular power or by the electric motor with which it is equipped, or by both.

## **Exemption**

**3.** Part I and section 91 of the Act shall not apply to any power-assisted bicycle that —

- (a) complies with the requirements specified in the Schedule to the Road Traffic (Power-Assisted Bicycles Approval) Rules 2004 (G.N. No. S 768/2004); and
- (b) has been approved and sealed in accordance with those Rules.
