In exercise of the powers conferred by section 10(1) of the Street Works Act 1995, the Land Transport Authority of Singapore makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification is the Street Works (Creation of Rights) Notification 2022.

Powers of Authority

2. The Authority or any person authorised by the Authority may, at any reasonable time and for the purposes of and incidental to the maintenance of a road structure or road related facility, enter upon the land described as MK10-03857P pt (called in this Notification the specified land) and exercise such rights as are described in the Schedule in, under or over the specified land.

Inspection of plan

- **3.** Copies of the plan of the specified land are available for inspection by the public free of charge at the office of the Land Transport Authority of Singapore at 1 Hampshire Road, Singapore 219428
 - (a) between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. of any day from Monday to Friday (except public holidays); but
 - (b) if any such day is the eve of the New Year, Lunar New Year or Christmas, between 9 a.m. and 12 noon.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

- 1. The right of uninterrupted passage with or without vehicles for the purpose of access to and egress from any road structure or road related facility constructed in or over the specified land or any other land adjoining to the specified land.
- 2. The right at all times to have any road structure or road related facility constructed by the Authority in or over the specified land to be supported, upheld and maintained by the soil and subsoil of such land.
