TOWN COUNCIL OF MARSILING-YEW TEE (PENALTIES FOR LATE PAYMENT OF CONSERVANCY AND SERVICE CHARGES) BY-LAWS 2016

ARRANGEMENT OF BY-LAWS

By-law

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24(2)(c) of the Town Councils Act, the Town Council for the Town of Marsiling-Yew Tee makes the following By-laws:

Citation and commencement

1. These By-laws are the Town Council of Marsiling-Yew Tee (Penalties for Late Payment of Conservancy and Service Charges) By-laws 2016 and come into operation on 1 April 2016.

Definitions

2. In these By-laws, unless the context otherwise requires —
“charge” means any conservancy and service charge (or any part of it);

“Town Council” means the Town Council for the Town of Marsiling-Yew Tee.

Calculation of penalties for charges in arrears

3. Where —

- (a) a charge payable by any tenant or owner to the Town Council, in respect of a property described in the Schedule, is in arrears; and
- (b) the aggregate of the tenant’s or owner’s charges in arrears in respect of that property equals or exceeds the monthly charges payable in respect of that property,

the tenant or owner is liable to pay for every month in which the aggregate of the charges in arrears equals or exceeds the monthly charges payable, a penalty at the appropriate rate set out in the Schedule.

Application of payment

4. The Town Council may, in its discretion, apply any moneys paid by a tenant or owner under these By-laws —

- (a) first towards the payment of any penalty payable under these By-laws; and
- (b) thereafter (if any balance remains) towards the payment of any charge that is in arrears.

Remission

5. The Town Council may, in its discretion, remit wholly or in part any penalty payable under these By-laws.

Cessation

6. The following by-laws cease to have effect with respect to the areas in the former Towns of Sembawang and Chua Chu Kang that are now comprised in the Town of Marsling-Yew Tee:

- (a) the Town Council of Sembawang-Nee Soon (Penalties for Late Payment of Conservancy and Service Charges) By-laws 2011 (G.N. No. S 704/2011);

- (b) the Town Council of Chua Chu Kang (Penalties for Late Payment of Conservancy and Service Charges and Licence Fees) By-laws 2011 (G.N. No. S 754/2011).

Transitional

7. Where any penalty that has been imposed by the Town Council under any by-laws in paragraph 6 remains unpaid on 31 March 2016, that penalty remains payable as if it had been imposed by the Town Council under these By-laws.

9. Office, shoplet or kiosk
- (a) \$10 if the monthly charges payable do not exceed \$100
 - (b) \$50 if the monthly charges payable exceed \$100 but do not exceed \$1,000
 - (c) \$200 if the monthly charges payable exceed \$1,000
10. Stall:
- (a) Cooked food stall \$20
 - (b) Fruit, preserved and dried goods, fresh fish and seafood, meat or poultry stall \$10
 - (c) Vegetable, bean curd and noodle, egg, ground assorted spices or miscellaneous stall \$10
 - (d) Piece and sundry stall \$10
11. Other commercial property
- (a) \$10 if the monthly charges payable do not exceed \$100
 - (b) \$50 if the monthly charges payable exceed \$100 but do not exceed \$1,000
 - (c) \$200 if the monthly charges exceed \$1,000
